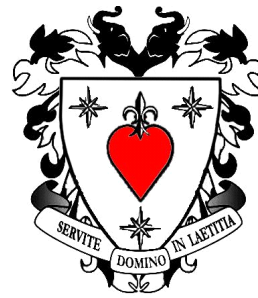

May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in Peace. Amen.



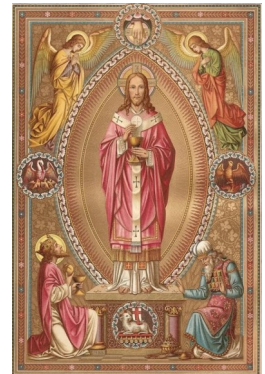

Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, Eternal High Priest *Thursday, 15 June*

On 15 June, the Church in Southern Africa celebrates the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, Eternal High Priest. The Letter to the Hebrews calls Our Lord the Great High Priest (cf. Heb. 7:23-28), who, especially in His Passion, has shown Himself to be the "Priest, the Altar and the Lamb of Sacrifice" (Preface of Easter, V), offering Himself to the Father for our redemption and for the salvation of the whole world. Holy Mass offered on this day will use the Propers for this Feast.
