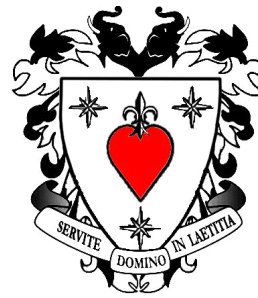

May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in Peace. Amen.

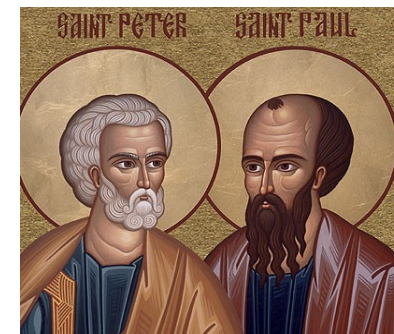
