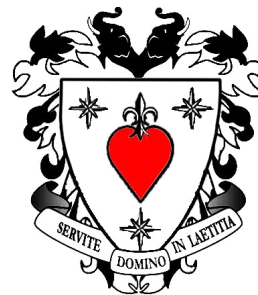

St Benedict feast 11th July

St Benedict was born in Norcia (Italy) and educated in Rome. Benedict decided to live as a hermit and settled in mountainous Subiaco, dwelling in a cave for three years. In about 525 Benedict settled at Monte Cassino, and disciples flocked to him as his reputation for holiness, wisdom, and miracles spread far and wide. He organized the monks into a single monastic community and wrote his famous *Rule* prescribing a life of moderate asceticism, prayer, study, and work, and community life under one superior. Stressing obedience and stability, the *Rule* has the Divine Office (Liturgy of the Hours) at the centre of monastic life; it had a profound effect on spiritual and monastic life in the West.
