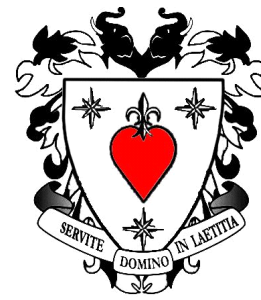

St Mary Magdalene, feast 22nd July

St Mary Magdalene is one of the greatest saints of the Bible and a wonderful example of God's mercy and grace. Converted from sin, she brought a number of other women to the Lord. During Jesus' ministry, it is believed that Mary Magdalene followed him, part of a semi-permanent entourage who served Jesus and his Disciples. Mary likely was present at the crucifixion along with the other women who followed Christ during His ministry. She was present when Christ rose from the dead, visiting his tomb to anoint his body only to find the stone rolled away. She was the first witness to His resurrection.
