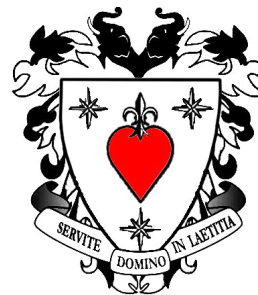

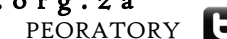

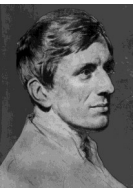
Solemnity of the Dedication of the Church

This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Dedication of our Church, in this 70th anniversary Year of our parish. *On this day we give thanks for this place of worship, under the patronage of St Bernadette, and ask God to renew us, living stones in the house of God, in his holy service.* (Nb. The readings for this feast are the same as those used on the feast of the Lateran Basilica [9 November] found in the back of the Sunday and Daily Missals)

On Monday 9th October we keep the feast of **Blessed John Henry Newman**. A famous Anglican preacher and writer, Newman was received into the Catholic Church in 1845.
