Second Collection: There will be a second collection at all Masses *next weekend* (21/22 October) for *World Mission Sunday*. This is the third of the Pontifical Mission Societies collections, taken up worldwide in October and used throughout the world to build churches, convents, catechetical facilities, assist with schools, seminaries, pastoral centres, etc. The collections are also sent to Rome and are allocated each year in May. The diocese is permitted five grant applications for each year but tries not to make use of all these because we aim at self-sufficiency. However, most of our churches, especially in the rural areas and poor communities, have been recipients of grants from Rome in the past. *Envelopes are available in the benches.*

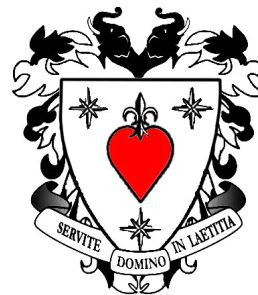
