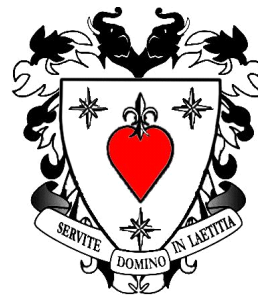

Solemnity of All Saints

This Sunday we keep the feast of All Saints, in which we give thanks to God that he has raised up countless men and women as examples of holiness in his church. Blessed Salvio Huix Miralpeix - Feast day 7th November

Salvio was born in 1877 in Catalonia, Spain, and ordained priest on 19 September 1903. Four years later he entered the Oratory of Vic; in 1927 he was named Bishop of Ibiza. In 1936 he was arrested with others by anti-Catholic Republican forces. He asked to be the last to be killed so as to give absolution and comfort to his companions in martyrdom. Blessed Salvio was beatified 13 October 2013.



In honour of Blessed Salvio there will be *Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament* at 5.15pm on Tuesday, before the evening Mass. Join the Oratorians for our joyful celebration of this martyr Son of St Philip.
