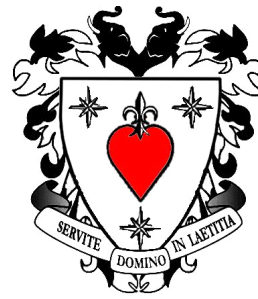

St Albert the Great Feast day 15th November

St Albert was one of the greatest glories of the Dominican Order. St. Thomas Aquinas was among his pupils. In 1260 he was named Bishop of Ratisbon and devoted himself zealously to the duties of his office. He died in Cologne in 1280.
