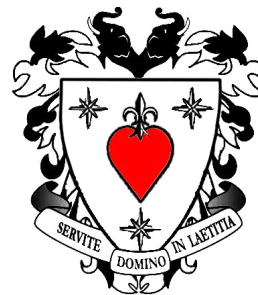
A parishioner is in urgent need of an **apartment to rent** in a safe and secure community. Please call 061 845 4174 or contact Ann at the parish office, if you can assist.

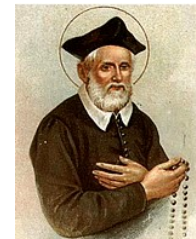

St Joseph Vaz of the Oratory – Tuesday 16th January

St Joseph Vaz (1651 - 1711) was an Oratorian priest from Goa, called the Apostle of Ceylon. After joining the Oratory in Goa, St Joseph undertook missionary work in Ceylon (now Sri Lanka) during the Dutch occupation, when Calvinism was the official religion, travelling throughout the island celebrating the sacraments for clandestine groups of Catholics. St Joseph was canonised in 2015 by Pope Francis.
