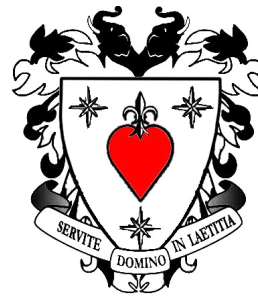

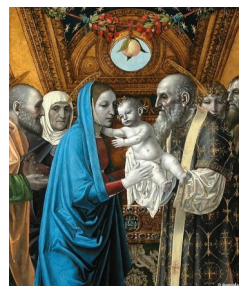

### ***Bd Sebastian Valfré of the Oratory—Tuesday 30th January***

Sebastian Valfré was born in 1629 in Alba in Piedmont, now north-west Italy, and joined the Oratory in Turin on St Philip's Day (26th May) 1651. As a priest, he was especially known for teaching Catechism, hearing confessions, giving spiritual direction, and helping the poor and sick. He was greatly devoted to the Shroud of Turin, repairs to which he himself actually undertook. Sebastian found perseverance in prayer difficult, but the effects of his prayer were sure to see – his patience, his zeal; his love for Christ present in the least of his brothers. He died in 1710.
